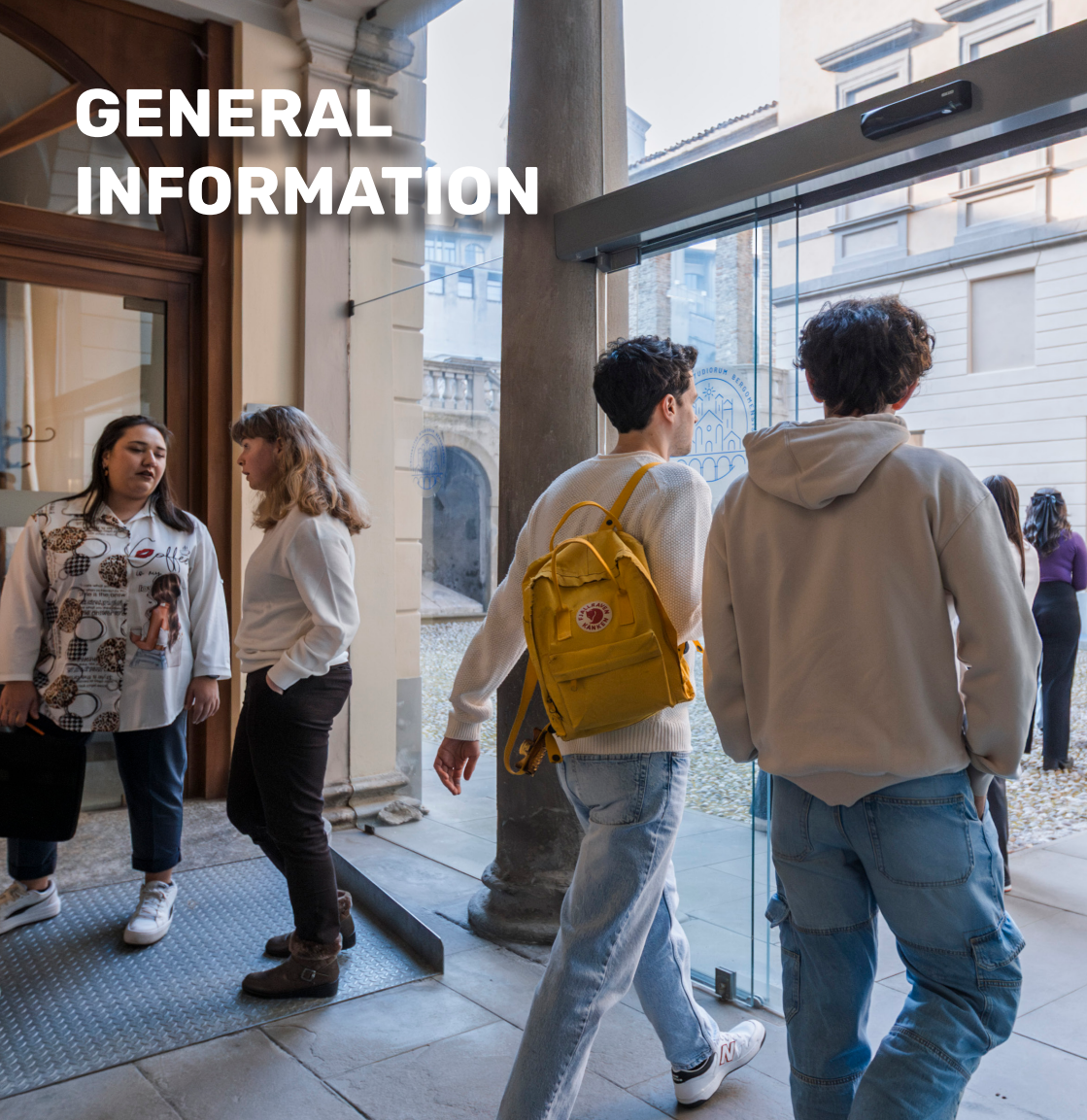

DEEPLY CONNECTED TO BERGAMO AND BEYOND

Founded in 1968 in a vibrant city near Milan, **UniBg is an integral part of Bergamo**, its territory, its history, and its culture. As an adaptive and forward-thinking university, we proactively respond to both **local and global challenges**.

FOUR REASONS TO CHOOSE UNIBG

- 1 The UniBg campuses combine **functionality and accessibility**, housing classrooms, three libraries, canteens, study rooms, laboratories, and relaxation areas. The Sant'Agostino complex and the Humanities Campus in the upper part of Bergamo hold historical significance, while the Economics and Law Campus in the low part of the city and the Engineering Campus in Dalmine (BG) are hubs of innovation and technology. Each location embraces green spaces, indoor gardens, or nearby parks.
 - 2 **UniBg recognizes and rewards student excellence**, offering partial or full tuition exemption of up to 10% for eligible students enrolled in three-year, five-year and single-cycle degree programs. Moreover, UniBg places international student mobility at the heart of its offering and, together with nine other European universities, is part of the **BAUHAUS4EU European University Alliance** (co-funded by the European Union). The Alliance builds on the New European Bauhaus (NEB) initiative, and embraces the values of sustainability, inclusivity and aesthetics.
 - 3 Our academic programs are designed to help students transition **into their professional career**. According to the 24th AlmaLaurea Graduate Profile Report, 77.9% of UniBg graduates secure employment within a year of graduation, rising to 92.4% within five years.
 - 4 Bergamo offers students **the services of a big city but on a personal scale**. Urban mobility is fast and efficient, and in twenty minutes by public transport you can get from the city center to Orio al Serio International Airport. Bergamo is a city full of history and culture, with no fewer than two UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and it is surrounded by the beautiful chain of the Orobie pre-Alps.

THE ITALIAN CREDIT SYSTEM

In the Italian credit system, CFU (*Credito Formativo Universitario*) is the unit of measurement for the workload required for a student to acquire competences and skills.

One CFU corresponds to 25 hours of learning, including lectures, workshops, seminars and independent study. Students earn CFUs by passing exams and completing their final dissertation, which are graded on a 30/30 scale for exams, and a 110/110 scale for final dissertation. 1 CFU corresponds to 1 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).

NAME	TAUGHT IN	SHORT DESCRIPTION
Lingue e letteratura straniere moderne [Modern Foreign Languages and Literatures]  Department of Foreign Languages, Literatures and Cultures	BA 	The BA program offers interdisciplinary expertise in foreign cultures (Arabic, Chinese, French, Japanese, English and Anglo-American, German, Russian, Spanish, and Hispano-American), organized into five curricula focused on: linguistics, philology and literature; oriental languages and cultures; tourism; intercultural and transmedial studies; linguistic mediation. Depending on the curriculum, students develop literary, historical, anthropological, geographical, economic, and sociological knowledge and skills for working in multilingual and multicultural environments worldwide.
Filosofia [Philosophy]  Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication	BA 	This BA program emphasizes two main areas: historical-philosophical and historical disciplines, particularly within the Italian tradition (<i>Historical and Philosophical Sciences</i> curriculum); and contemporary theoretical reflection (<i>Theoretical Philosophy</i> curriculum). Career opportunities for graduates include public institutions and private enterprises operating in fields such as education, publishing, journalism, cultural event organization, event planning, public relations, communications, and philosophical consultancy.
Lettere [Humanities]  Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication	BA 	This BA program offers a solid foundation in philological-linguistic, literary, historical, and artistic studies, with a focus on Italian and European cultural tradition. It includes two main curricula: <i>Letters</i> , where it is possible to choose between a focus on philological-didactic studies, on modern European literatures in a comparative perspective, or on literary studies combined with geohistory; <i>Fashion, Art, Design and Visual Culture</i> , exploring visual arts and cultures, including fashion, design, and cinema.

Scienze della comunicazione [Communication sciences] Limited enrollment program  <i>Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication</i>	BA 	This BA program explores processes, information and communication languages to meet the needs of businesses, organizations, and institutions. It emphasizes digital innovation, cultural and social changes. Coursework covers linguistic, information technology, human, social, legal and economic sciences, along with communication methods, analysis, and techniques. Students can choose from three curricula: <i>Business and Society</i> , <i>Institutions and Social Change</i> , <i>Media and Culture</i> .

Intercultural Studies in Languages and Literatures  <i>Department of Foreign Languages, Literatures and Cultures</i>	MA 	In this MA program, students take all or most of their exams in English or in different languages chosen from Italian, English, Spanish, French, German, or Russian. The program prepares for careers in teaching, cultural production and promotion, publishing, multimedia communication and human resources management. Students specialize in one or two foreign languages and two foreign literatures, supported by advanced studies in historical, philological and linguistic studies, and academic and literary translation.
Lingue moderne per la comunicazione e la cooperazione internazionale [Modern Languages for International Communication and Cooperation]  <i>Department of Foreign Languages, Literatures and Cultures</i>	MA 	This MA Program provides high-level training in two foreign languages chosen from Italian, English, Spanish, French, German, Russian, Arabic, Japanese, or Chinese. Preparing for diverse professional sectors in national and international contexts, the program integrates theoretical and practical foundations of translation and communication with economic and legal, socio-territorial, and historical disciplines, in two distinct curricula: <i>Linguistic Mediation for Business</i> and <i>Institutions and International Cooperation</i> .

Planning and Management of Tourism Systems  <i>Department of Foreign Languages, Literatures and Cultures</i>	MA 	This MA program trains professionals by providing a solid overall background, forming specialized expertise in the analysis of tourism from a historical-cultural perspective, the analysis of territories and their environment (including socio-economic perspectives), and planning, management and organization of activities for the development of sustainable and responsible tourism and the promotion of the historical and human capital of diverse geographical and cultural realities.
Geourbanistica [Geourbanistics] <i>Interdepartmental:</i>  <i>Department of Foreign Languages, Literatures and Cultures</i>  <i>Department Engineering and Applied Sciences</i>  <i>Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication</i>	MA 	This MA program aims to train the Geourbanist, a professional who integrates geographical and urban sciences as a foundation for territorial analysis, urban planning, the use of Geographic Information Systems, mapping technologies, and communication to support governance. Geourbanistics relies on collaborative learning methodologies, and students can choose between two curricula: <i>Sustainable places and networks</i> , and <i>Paesaggi e patrimonio culturale</i> .
Philosophical Knowledge: Foundations, Methods, Applications  <i>Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication</i> <i>Inter-university:</i>  <i>University of Bergamo</i>  <i>University of Pavia</i>  <i>IUSS University School of Advanced Studies in Pavia</i>	MA 	This MA program provides advanced training in philosophical disciplines such as ontology, metaphysics, ethics, bioethics, epistemology, logic, philosophy of language, science, mind, and technology, including artificial intelligence. Focusing on foundational debates, the curriculum integrates philosophy with applied sciences, technology, business management, neuroscience, sustainability, healthcare systems, and the ontology of intellectual property, training students to transfer their skills to various professional contexts.

Filosofia, scienze e società [Philosophy, sciences and society] Interdepartmental: - Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication - Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program offers high-level training in philosophical thought as a cultural response to contemporary global challenges. It develops analytical and interdisciplinary skills through two curricula: <i>Mind, Knowledge, Reality</i>, focusing on logic and cognition; and <i>Thought, History, Contemporary World</i>, emphasizing social and historical understanding for critical reflection and professional versatility. The program prepares students for research, teaching, and careers requiring analytical writing and argumentative reasoning.
Comunicazione, informazione, editoria [Communication, Information, Publishing] Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication	MA 	This MA program trains creative professionals equipped to navigate the evolving media landscape across public and private sectors, both in Italy and abroad. It offers three curricula: <i>Communication for Businesses and Public Institutions</i>, focused on internal and external communication processes; <i>Information and Data Cultures</i>, exploring the transformation of media and digital storytelling; and <i>Publishing and Communication for Creative Industries</i>, centered on cross-media content creation and distribution.
Culture umanistiche [Humanistic cultures] Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication	MA 	This MA program offers advanced interdisciplinary training in philological-linguistic, literary, historical, and artistic disciplines. Centered on European cultural and literary traditions from antiquity to the present, it fosters critical thinking and contextual understanding across eras. It offers two curricula: <i>Historical-Literary and Philological Teaching</i>, for careers in education and literary research, and <i>Comparative Artistic and Literary Cultures</i>, focused on interdisciplinary approaches to artistic production.
Valorizzazione del patrimonio culturale materiale e immateriale [Enhancement of material and non material cultural heritage] Department of Letters, Philosophy and Communication	MA 	This MA program trains professionals with expertise in the preservation, analysis, and communication of cultural assets, with a focus on museums, archives, and libraries. In the second year, students choose between two curricula: <i>Cultural Heritage Analysis</i>, dedicated to advanced research in archival science, library studies, and cultural conservation; and <i>Cultural Heritage Communication</i>, focused on digital strategies for promoting artistic and museological heritage as drivers of territorial and social innovation.

Scienze dell'Educazione [Education studies] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	BA 	This BA program offers foundational training for future socio-pedagogical educators across a broad spectrum of settings: early childhood services, community and social care, adult and elderly support, employment counseling, and educational outreach. The curriculum fosters pedagogical, methodological, and cultural expertise. The program prepares graduates to work in both public and private institutions engaged in welfare, lifelong learning, and social innovation.
Scienze psicologiche [Psychological studies] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	BA 	This BA program provides foundational knowledge across all major fields of psychology: general, developmental, clinical, social, and organizational psychology, psychobiology, and psychometrics. Students develop analytical and contextual skills, and the program includes professional training and internships. Graduates acquire the skills to assist licensed psychologists in education, clinical settings, public institutions, and private organizations, with a focus on professional readiness and cultural reflection.
Scienze motorie e sportive [Human movement and sport sciences] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	BA 	This BA program aims to offer interdisciplinary training combining physical and sports disciplines with biomedical, philosophical, psychological, anthropological, legal-managerial, linguistic, and technological fields. Students gain technical and socio-educational skills to work with people of all ages. Emphasizing human complexity and well-being, the program fosters versatile professionals capable of designing innovative projects and contributing to inclusive, community-centered sport environments.

Scienze della Formazione primaria [Primary teacher education] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	SC 	This Single-Cycle Degree program prepares future teachers for preschool and primary school through interdisciplinary training in subject knowledge, classroom management, and instructional design, including multimedia approaches. Students gain immediate exposure to the school system, acquire competencies in inclusive education, and are equipped to participate in the national teaching qualification process, while ensuring age-appropriate and culturally responsive teaching skills across disciplinary areas.

Master's Programs in SOCIAL SCIENCES

Clinical Psychology for Individuals, Families and Organizations Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program trains professionals to address both personal and work-related psychological issues across individual, family, and organizational settings. Combining theoretical study with active learning methods, the program integrates neuroscientific, clinical, and psychodynamic approaches. Students engage with diagnostic and therapeutic techniques for trauma and personality disorders and complete a mandatory traineeship to qualify for clinical practice in Italy.
Psicologia clinica [Clinical Psychology] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program offers advanced theoretical and experiential training focused on mental health in clinical and social contexts. Students explore bio-psycho-social dimensions, deepen epistemological knowledge, and master diagnostic, evaluative, and intervention techniques. The curriculum emphasizes cross-sectoral well-being promotion and problem-based learning. Graduates are prepared for work in healthcare, community, justice, and educational settings.
Psicologia della salute nei contesti sociali, organizzativi e di comunità [Health psychology in social, organizational, and community contexts] ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program trains the innovative figure of the health psychologist to operate in various life contexts. The program provides knowledge and skills to implement interventions aimed at individual and collective psychological well-being, preventing risks, promoting resources, building networks, and activating processes of social change.

Scienze pedagogiche [Pedagogic sciences] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program provides interdisciplinary training to address contemporary educational challenges with creativity and responsibility. Students develop specialist knowledge and skills in educational planning, pedagogical consultancy, and the management of socio-educational and training services. Depending on the study plan, the course leads to careers in educational consultancy, service coordination, or teaching, combining theoretical reflection with professional practice.
Scienze, metodi e didattiche delle attività sportive [Sciences, methods and didactics of sports activities] Limited enrollment program ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences Inter-university: ■ University of Bergamo/ University of Salento	MA 	This MA program offers advanced training in two core areas: basic-level sport and school-based physical education. The curriculum blends technical-sports expertise with psycho-pedagogical and communication skills. Students complete an internship with national and local sports bodies. Graduates are equipped to design, manage, and deliver sport and wellness programs across educational, social, and therapeutic settings, including work with vulnerable populations.
Progettazione di contesti di vita accessibili ed inclusivi [Design of accessible and inclusive living contexts] ■ Department of Human and Social Sciences	MA 	This MA program prepares professionals to design technological solutions that promote autonomy and social inclusion. With a strong interdisciplinary and experiential approach, students develop skills to create environments and communities that foster participation, accessibility, and well-being. Delivered primarily online, the program prepares graduates to respond to social needs using innovative tools, and to enhance the quality of life for all, especially vulnerable populations.

Diritto per l'impresa nazionale e internazionale [Legal services for national and international business]  Department of Law	BA 	This BA program offers multidisciplinary legal training for careers in business, human resources, public administration, and international organizations. Students gain expertise in constitutional, commercial, labor, tax, and EU law, as well as legal informatics and economics. Four career paths are available: <i>Labor consultancy and HR, Private Enterprise, European and International Law, and Public Procurement</i> . The program prepares graduates for roles such as legal advisor, HR specialist, or consultant in legal informatics.
Scienze Politiche e Strategie Globali [Political sciences and global strategies]  Department of Law	BA 	This BA programme provides interdisciplinary training on the political, economic and social phenomena of the contemporary world. From an international perspective, it offers analytical tools for understanding global dynamics and public decision-making processes. The course is carried out in collaboration with other departments of the University of Bergamo.

Single-cycle's Program in LAW

Giurisprudenza [Law]  Department of Law	SC 	This Single-Cycle program provides comprehensive legal education spanning national and international frameworks. The course offers three paths: <i>Legal Professions, Corporate Law, and Legal Expertise for Public and the Third Sector</i> . The curriculum covers civil, constitutional, criminal, labor, and EU law, alongside philosophical, economic, and comparative disciplines. Graduates can pursue careers as lawyers, magistrates, or notaries, or take on positions of responsibility in business and public institutions.

It prepares graduates to design and manage development programs through international organizations, public administrations, NGOs, and multinational enterprises. The program emphasizes critical contributions to migration and cooperation policy-making.

NAME	TAUGHT IN	SHORT DESCRIPTION
Economia aziendale [Business Administration] Limited enrollment program  <i>Department of Management</i>	BA  	This BA program offers solid training to analyze and manage diverse companies, from SMEs to global firms, public bodies, and nonprofits. Students acquire skills in corporate strategy, management control, HR, marketing, accounting, and finance through lectures, labs, internships, and direct interaction with professionals. Four distinct curricula are offered: <i>Business Administration</i> (in English), <i>Administration and Control</i>, <i>Management and International Business</i> and <i>Finance</i>.
Economia [Economics] Limited enrollment program  <i>Department of Economics</i>	BA 	This BA program provides the skills to analyze a dynamic world where businesses, governments, institutions, and citizens interact. Students gain solid foundations in microeconomics, macroeconomics, policy, and quantitative methods, along with specialized fields like labor, industrial, and international economics. Graduates are prepared for careers in private firms, public institutions, NGOs, and international organizations, or to continue with advanced studies.
Data Analytics, economia e tecnologie digitali [Data Analytics, Economics and Digital Technologies] Interdepartmental:  <i>Department of Economics</i>  <i>Department of Management</i>  <i>Department of Management, Information and Production Engineering</i>	BA 	This BA program trains students to manage and analyze big data using statistics and AI, turning raw information into insights for decision-making. The program combines solid foundations in math, statistics, and computer science with practical skills in data collection, cleaning, modeling, and visualization, as well as in cybersecurity and ethics. Two paths are available: <i>Economic-Statistical</i> and <i>Computer-Engineering</i>, preparing graduates for careers as skilled data analysts in many fields.

Economics and Data Analysis  <i>Department of Economics</i>		This MA program equips students with advanced economics knowledge and cutting-edge statistical methods to meet the challenges of the information and big data era. Students develop analytical and decision-making skills to evaluate policies in both private and public sectors, combining theory with practical experience. Tuition Fees and Scholarships

FEES

Students pay their fees in **two yearly installments**:

- A fee based on the student's income range (minimum 200,00€) plus a regional fee of that ranges from 146,00€ to 206,00€ depending on the income range.
- The second installment is the difference between the total fee (minimum 0,00€; maximum 1.983,00€ within the regular duration of the program; maximum 2.563,00 € beyond the standard duration of the program) calculated on the student's financial situation, the course of enrollment and the first installment. For fee up 430,00€, both installments are combined in a single payment.
