**1) The General Courses (60 hrs)** consist of two two-hour classes a week during the semester and are mostly held in different university buildings. Classes will be formed according to different levels from level A1 to C1.

At the end of each course, students will receive a certificate of attendance.

Students attending at least 50% of the classes and taking the Final Exam will be assigned 5 ects credits per semester.

All Exchange/ERASMUS students who would like to take the General courses are obliged to take an ASSESSMENT/ENTRY TEST in order to determine their proficiency at the beginning of the semester.

**2) Special Courses (30 hrs)** consist of one two-hour classes a week during the semester and are mostly held in different university buildings. Please pay attention to the minimum level required (see below).

At the end of each course, students will receive a certificate of attendance.

Students attending at least 50% of the classes and taking the Final Exam will be assigned 3 ects credits per semester.
