## **Period: 29 June-10 July 2020**

- 3) 'Make' in Italy: An Introduction to Entrepreneurship and Startupping. (C/o Cyfe, Center for Young and Family Enterprise, PM Prof. Davide Hahn)
- 4) Anthropology of Children and Childhood. (Prof. David Rosen, Fairleigh Dickinson University)

All the courses are held in English Possibility to choose 1 or 2 courses within the same period (up to 4 courses in total) International classes with maximum 25 students per class 5/6 academic credits for each course COSTS of the SUMMER SCHOOL
