Arrival/Departure certificate

Arrival certificate

is provided by your home University.

It indicates the date of your arrival in Bergamo which corresponds to the beginning of academic activities (ig Italian intensive courses, general courses) or the Welcome meeting.

Departure certificate

is provided by your home University.

The end date of the study period is the last day the student had to be present at the Receiving Institution for academic purposes (ig courses/exams) not his actual date of departure.



exam)


 There are several "appelli" (dates) for each exam and you can choose the most convenient date for you

The **changes** to the learning agreement must be approved by:

- The student
- The sending institution
- The receiving institution



The University of Bergamo will accept:

A PDF version of your Learning Agreement.

This must respect either your Home University format or the standard one that you can find below. Other format will not be accepted. The Learning Agreement should be typed and not handwritten.


*Such activities are <u>mandatory for students in the language department</u> but are strongly recommended for all students


Log in using your username and password to access your reserved area

Here you can check your classes timetable, search for your exams and consult the rooms daily planning






You can access the same information by downloading the **EasyUnibg app** for your mobile phone: create a profile and edit the app with the teaching units you are interested in
